

Cancellation Policy:

If you must cancel an appointment, you are required to call at least 24-hours in advance of your schedule appointment.

Failure to notify the clinic of cancellation or failure to attend a scheduled appointment will result in removal from receiving services for a period of one year.



***Tips for Taking Care
of Your Teeth***



Prevention is the best way to stop tooth decay!

Poor Dental Health can lead to:

- ◆ Bad breath
- ◆ Bleeding gums
- ◆ Loosing teeth
- ◆ Trouble getting a job
- ◆ Health problems like diabetes, heart disease and having unhealthy babies



Rotten teeth can be caused by germs in your mouth that grow because you

- ◆ Drink sugary drinks
- ◆ Have poor dental care
- ◆ Smoke
- ◆ Chew tobacco
- ◆ Take street drugs
- ◆ Eat junk food and sugary snacks

There are four basic steps to care for teeth and gums:

1. Brush your teeth twice daily
2. Floss every day
3. Eat a healthy diet and limit unhealthy snacks
4. Visit a dentist



- ✓ Do you have tooth pain?
- ✓ Don't have a dentist?
- ✓ Haven't seen a dentist in years?
- ✓ No dental insurance?
- ✓ Are you pregnant?
- ✓ Are you a Brown County resident?

If you answered yes to the above questions, you may qualify for free or low cost dental care from one of the following programs.

Adults

- ◆ If you have **Badgercare/Medicaid and have tooth pain or are pregnant**, call the NEW Dental Clinic at NWTC at **920-272-9300** for more information or to schedule an appointment.
- ◆ If you want your teeth cleaned, call the NWTC Dental Hygiene Clinic at **920-498-5450**.
- ◆ If you do not have Badgercare/Medicaid, do not have dental insurance, **and** your income is at or less than 125% of the federal poverty level you may qualify for dental services. Call the NEW Community Clinic at NWTC **920-437-9773** for more information or to schedule an appointment.

Children

- ◆ The Oral Health Partnership of Brown County provides dental services for children residing in Brown County. Call **920-965-0831** for more information or to schedule an appointment.
- ◆ If you have Medical Assistance, are low income (qualify for free or reduced lunch) and do not have dental insurance you may qualify for dental assistance.
