

RESOLUTION #22-10

AMENDING RESOLUTION #21-113 (Adoption of Tax Levy for City Purposes to Support the 2022 City Budget) BY REAPPORTIONMENT OF \$87,950 FROM GENERAL FUND – UNASSIGNED RESERVES AND \$49,427 FROM THE POOL REFERENDUM FUND FOR ADDITIONAL STAFFING POSITIONS AND TWO ADDITIONAL CUBICLES FOR CITY HALL SECOND FLOOR

WHEREAS, after due deliberation and public discussion, the De Pere Common Council approved the 2022 City Budget and adopted a tax levy to support such Budget on November 16, 2021 (Resolution #21-113); and

WHEREAS, said Resolution apportioned the total tax levy of \$15,386,809 as follows:

General Fund (\$8,615,156); Debt Service (\$4,049,205); Capital Projects (\$1,742,276); and Local Levy TID Districts (\$980,172); and

WHEREAS, the City has determined to amend the 2022 City Budget by increasing total budgeted expenditures by \$137,377 (\$87,950 from the General Fund-Unassigned Reserves and \$49,427 from the Pool Referendum Fund) to fund salary and benefits for the following positions, as well as two additional cubicles for City Hall Second Floor:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:

The Common Council hereby amends the General Fund expenditures in the 2021 property tax levy to support the City's 2022 budget by increasing the \$8,615,156 total budgeted allocation by \$137,377 (\$87,950 from the General Fund-Unassigned Reserves and \$49,427 from the Pool Referendum Fund).

The City Clerk shall, within 15 days of the passage of this Resolution, publish a Class I notice of the changes made herein as required under Wis. Stats. §65.90(5)(a).
