Snow emergency declared in De Pere (Jan. 9-10, 2024)

DE PERE – Due to potential significant winter weather and snow fall incoming, and in accordance with De Pere City Ordinance 150-10, the De Pere Chief of Police has declared a snow emergency starting on Tuesday, Jan. 9, 2024, at 5 am. This will last through Wednesday, Jan. 10, 2024, at 6 am.

No parking on streets

No vehicles should be parked on De Pere streets during this period to facilitate snow plowing operations. Any parked vehicle in the roadway during this time is subject to enforcement action that could include being towed at the owner's expense, if the vehicle poses a major obstacle for plowing.

If the weather forecasts are accurate, this will be a lengthy snow event requiring multiple plow crew operational periods. Thank you for your cooperation.

Also, please note, no on-street parking is allowed between 2 am and 5 am on weekdays in the City of De Pere. Therefore, regardless of the snow emergency, please keep your vehicles off the street at these times as well to aid public works' crews and comply with City ordinance.

Driver safety

During this lengthy winter weather event, all residents are urged to reduce or eliminate any travel during this storm. If you need to be on the road for any reason, please drive carefully. Also, please give snowplow operators plenty of space to conduct their operations.
