De Pere seeking applicants for Common Council opening in District 4

DE PERE, Wis. — The City of De Pere is seeking an individual to fill a vacant position on De Pere Common Council. This vacancy has been created due to the resignation of alderperson John Quigley, who is moving from the area.

De Pere alderpersons serve three-year terms. The individual chosen for this opening would be completing the remaining three years on Alderperson Quigley's current term, which concludes in April 2028.

Select applicants will undergo interviews during the week of Aug. 11.

Please note: there will not be a special election. The Mayor and Council President will interview applicants and select a candidate to fill the remainder of the term. The Common Council must approve the applicant for appointment.

It is also important to note this open alderperson position would fill one spot on Common Council representing District 4. For this reason, applicants must reside in District 4 of the City of De Pere to apply. Council meetings are held on the first and third Tuesday of each month, and alderpersons are also expected to serve on various boards and commissions. The City of De Pere operates with four Aldermanic Districts, with two alderpersons representing each district, totaling eight alderpersons. Council members are elected on a non-partisan basis for three-year overlapping terms. The City Council plays a crucial role in addressing matters affecting the city, including policy implementation, ordinance enactments, and overall city governance.
