Casey Nelson selected to fill vacant District 4 alderperson seat

DE PERE, Wis. — Casey Nelson has been selected by Mayor James Boyd to fill a vacant position on the De Pere Common Council. This vacancy was created by the resignation of former District 4 alderperson John Quigley, who moved from the area.

De Pere alderpersons serve three-year terms. Nelson's appointment was approved by the Common Council at its meeting last night. He will be completing the remaining years on Quigley's existing term, which concludes in April 2028. He will also take over Quigley's committee and board assignments as well.

Nelson previously served on De Pere's Common Council and returns to fill one of two seats representing District 4. De Pere's other alderperson representing District 4 is Dan Carpenter.

Council meetings are held on the first and third Tuesday of each month. The City of De Pere operates with four Aldermanic Districts, with two alderpersons representing each district, totaling eight alderpersons. Council members are elected on a non-partisan basis for three-year overlapping terms. The Common Council plays a crucial role in addressing matters affecting the city, including policy implementation, ordinance enactments, and overall city governance.
