The Common Council hereby approves the transfer of funds from City's Unassigned Reserves account in the amount of \$3,000 and authorizes the

allocation to Account 100-53400-340 (Traffic Signs and Markings-Operating

Supplies).

That all city officials, officers and employees are authorized and directed to take

such steps as are lawful and necessary in furtherance thereof.
