## **ARTICLE XI SIGNS**

## 14-111 Sandwich Board Signs (1) Allowed in the mixed-use districts (MX-1, MX-2, MX-3, GX1 & GX-2):

- 14-112 (10) Sandwich Board Signs (a) Uses. A sandwich board sign may be permitted within the city right-of-way for use with public sidewalk frontage in mixed-use districts, subject to compliance with the regulations of this subsection.
  - (b) Dimensional/Design Standards.
  - 1. Sign face area may not exceed 8 square feet per sign face.
  - 2. Sign width face may not exceed 2 feet measured at the widest point of the sign face.
  - 3. Sign height may not exceed 4 feet measured from the sidewalk beneath the sign to the top of the sign.
  - 4. A ballast must be installed at the base of the sandwich board sign to ensure stability in windy conditions.
  - 5. Signs must be portable and may not be permanently affixed to any structure.
  - 6. The sign may not be painted traffic-yellow or construction zone orange, nor may it be reflective, fluorescent, or illuminated.
  - 7. Signs may not resemble or contain any MUTCD-compliant traffic control devices in size, shape message or color.
