De Pere holiday garbage/recycling collection schedule outlined

De Pere, Wis. - Due to Christmas and New Years holidays, the City of De Pere Public Works office will be closed on Dec. 24 and 25, 2018, as well as Jan. 1, 2019. Garbage and recycling collection will still be offered at various times throughout this holiday stretch, so residents should please make note of the following schedule.

Week of December 24-28, 2018

Monday— December 24 Monday routes will be collected

Tuesday— December 25 HOLIDAY—CLOSED

Wednesday— December 26 Tuesday routes will be collected
Thursday— December 27 Wednesday routes will be collected
Friday— December 28 Thursday routes will be collected

Week of Dec. 31, 2018, and Jan. 1-4, 2019

Monday—December 31 Monday routes will be collected

Tuesday—January 1 HOLIDAY—CLOSED

Wednesday—January 2 Tuesday routes will be collected
Thursday—January 3 Wednesday routes will be collected
Friday—January 4 Thursday routes will be collected

We ask all residents to cooperate by placing their garbage and recycling at the curb by 6:30 a.m., as crews CANNOT be sent back to those locations where garbage and recycling was not placed out early enough for collection.

Overflow: Garbage overflow pick-up is Dec. 26, 27, 28 and 31. There will be another round of overflow pick-up on Jan. 2, 3, 4 and 7. All extra bags must be set away from container so they do not interfere with the automated collection process.

Curbside Christmas Tree Collection will begin on Wednesday, Jan. 2, through Friday, Jan. 11, 2019. Please remove plastic bags and decorations from trees before placing the trees at the curb for collection. Residents may also bring the trees to the compost site located on Rockland Road.
