## PROCLAIMING FRIDAY, APRIL 29, 2022 "ARBOR DAY" IN THE CITY OF DE PERE

WHEREAS, in 1872, J. Sterling Morton proposed to the Nebraska Board of Agriculture that a special day be set aside for planting of trees; and

**WHEREAS**, this holiday, called "Arbor Day," was first observed with the planting of more than one million trees in Nebraska; and

WHEREAS, Arbor Day is now observed throughout the nation and the world; and

**WHEREAS**, trees can reduce the erosion of our precious topsoil by wind and water, cut heating and cooling costs, moderate the temperature, clean the air, produce oxygen, and provide habitat for wildlife; and

**WHEREAS**, trees are a renewable resource, giving us paper, wood for our homes, fuel for our fires, and countless other wood products; and

**WHEREAS**, trees, wherever they are planted, are a source of joy and spiritual renewal.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, James G. Boyd, Mayor of the City of De Pere, Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me, do hereby proclaim Friday, April 29, 2022,

"ARBOR DAY"

in the City of De Pere and urge all citizens to plant trees to gladden the hearts and promote the well-being of present and future generations.
