

Weekly Project Status

Anticipated Construction for the Week of Monday, May 18, 2026

The purpose of the document is to provide a brief update on the anticipated weekly activities on the construction projects occurring in the City.

Project 25-04 – American Boulevard Utility Extension

Contractor – PTS Contractors, Inc.

Overall Project Description – Project involves the extension of utilities and street grading and gravelling for American Boulevard from the cul de sac south of Garroman Drive to the southerly City limits.

There will be minimal impacts to traffic, excluding a storm crossing of Garroman Drive, which will require a one-day closure in the future.

Weekly Update:

- **Site grading will continue and storm sewer construction will start. There are no traffic impacts this week.**

Project 25-11 – Redevelopment Street and Utility Construction

Contractor – Kruczek Construction, Inc.

Overall Project Description – Project involves utility and street reconstruction for redevelopment at the following locations:

Weekly Update:

- Williams Street – Wisconsin Street to Michigan Street - No work is scheduled this week.
- Wisconsin Street – James Street to Williams Street – No work is scheduled this week.

Project 26-01 – Sewer and Water Relay and Street Resurfacing

Contractor – Kruczek Construction, Inc.

Overall Project Description – Project involves sanitary sewer, storm sewer, and water main relay and street reconstruction or resurfacing on the following streets:

Weekly Update:

- Georgia Drive – Cook Street to northern cul-de-sac – No work is scheduled this week.
- Lebrun Street – McCastlen Street to East River Drive - No work is scheduled this week.
- Lee Avenue – Amhart Drive to Helena Street - No work is scheduled this week.
- Marsh Street – Fourth Street to Third Street – **Utility work will start on Wednesday, May 20.**
- Pennings Avenue – Amhart Drive to Helena Street – No work is scheduled this week.
- S. Sixth Street – Lande Street to Helena Street – No work is scheduled this week.

Streets will be closed to through traffic throughout construction.

The De Pere Dog Park (1400 Biotech Way) will also be closed on Monday, May 18 to accommodate minor utility replacement work.

Project 26-04 – Ontario Street Reconstruction

Contractor – Kruczek Construction, Inc.

Overall Project Description – Project involves sanitary sewer, storm sewer, and water main relay and street reconstruction on the following streets:

Weekly Update:

- Ontario Street – George Street to Ridgeway Boulevard – **Utility work will continue.**
- Franklin Street – Erie Street to Ontario Street – **Utility work will continue**

Streets will be closed to through traffic throughout construction.

Project 26-05 – Sidewalk and Curb Repairs

Contractor – Al Dix Concrete, Inc.

Overall Project Description – Project involves miscellaneous sidewalk and curb work throughout the City. The sidewalk repair area being completed this year is on the west side of the Fox River in an area bounded by Grant Street on the north, the CN Railroad tracks on the east, Scheuring Road on the south, and western city limits.

The project also includes sidewalk gaps ordered in by the City and some park improvements.

Weekly Update:

No work is anticipated this week.

I41/CTH GV Interchange Work – Wisconsin Department of Transportation

French Road will now remain closed while the new interchange is being constructed. The anticipated date for opening the roundabout connecting French Road back to Southbridge Road is Memorial Day weekend.
